**Genus & Species:** Hedera canariensis

Protection Status: PP 34,168

**Bloom:** Foliage selection. **Bloom Period:** Foliage selection.

Foliage: Large glossy foliage 3-4" wide by 5-6" long. Unique highly variegated leaves, gold to pure white

marbling and flecking. Bright colorful pink new stems.

**Habit:** Evergreen climber or efficient ground cover. Species Ultimately 15-20' x 20-60'.

**Propagation:** Softwood Cuttings. *License required for propagation.* 

**Culture:** Happy in sun to full shade, in any soil that is not waterlogged. **Additional Comments:** Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching.

**Uses:** House plant, ground cover, seasonal containers, baskets and mass landscape planting.
