Genus & Species: Dahlia variabilis (Hort). (Code: 71850-05)

Bloom: Unique striped flowers in hot cerise tones with bold magenta stripes. Flowers highlighted with

dark central discs.

Bloom Period: Early summer– fall.

Foliage: Glossy mahogany-black foliage.

Habit: Compact rounded habit. No staking required. 30" x 20".

Propagation: Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, in rich moist well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Nectar rich blooms, great for beneficial pollinating insects. Bred for long season of interest in patio

pots & containers.

Uses: Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
