Characteristics

Genus & Species:Euphorbia amygdaloidesProtection Status:US Plant Patent 22,200.USDA Zone:Zone 6-11. (-10°F or -23°C).

Bloom: Masses of fresh apple green bracts.

Bloom Time: Early summer - fall.

Foliage: Unique ruby red new foliage with contrasting bright cherry red stems.

Habit: Squat compact-spreading habit. 16" x 20".

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Well-drained soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Prune flowering stem hard back to the base after blooming has

finished.

Uses: Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
