<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Zone 7. (0°F or -17°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Eye catching pure white and green variegated bracts.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early summer - fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Eye catching variegated foliage green to blue-green in color with bold crisp white margins.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tiny compact rounded habit. 18" x 18".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Well-drained soil in full sun.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Prune flowering stem hard back to the base after flowering to encourage strong new shoots. Great for low water use landscapes.
<b>Uses:</b>	Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks</b>
