Characteristics

Genus & Species: Euphorbia characias subsp. wulfenii

Protection Status: US Plant Patent 15,715. USDA Zone: Zone 7. (0°F or -17°C).

Bloom: Eye catching pure white and green variegated bracts.

Bloom Time: Early summer - fall.

Foliage: Eye catching variegated foliage green to blue-green in color with bold crisp white margins.

Habit: Tiny compact rounded habit. 18" x 18".

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Well-drained soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Prune flowering stem hard back to the base after flowering to

encourage strong new shoots. Great for low water use landscapes.

Uses: Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape.
