Bloom: Abundant reddish flower heads turning into buff seedheads.

Bloom Time: July-October.

Foliage: Elegant graceful arching foliage emerging green in spring coloring from early may through summer

into striking carmine and purple tones in October and November (European Fall). Centers of the

clumps stay fresh green giving an attractive two tone affect.

Habit: Tidy clumping habit 2-3' x 2-3'.

Propagation: Division & TC. *License required for propagation.* **Culture:** Fertile well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. The perfect selection for smaller modern gardens.

Uses: Containers, garden border, modern courtyard & landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 8-10 weeks 2 Gallon: 12-16 weeks
