Characteristics

Genus & Species:Miscanthus sinensisProtection Status:US Plant Patent 21,788.USDA Zone:Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).

Bloom: Flowerheads are silky bronze in color, drying to russet fall tones. Attractive if left uncut thought

the winter months.

Bloom Time: July-October.

Foliage: Attractive green foliage with bold variegated horizontal banding becoming stronger as

temperatures increase.

Habit: Tight clumping habit 5-7' x 3-4'.

Propagation: Division & TC. *License required for propagation.* **Culture:** Fertile well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Controlled cross of M. 'Strictus' x M. 'Cosmopolitan'

Uses: Garden border, modern courtyard, landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 8-12 weeks 2 Gallons: 12-16 weeks

Closest Variety: M. 'Zebrinus'

Key Differences:

- √ 'Tiger Tail' upright-spreading habit vs. strongly upright habit.
- √ 'Tiger Tail' medium stems vs. stiff upright stems.
- √ 'Tiger Tail' average flowering vs. increased flower number.
