Characteristics

Genus & Species: Nemesia hybrida. (Code: W1051)

Protection Status: Rights Asserted.

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C).

Bloom: Elegant bicolor flowers in deep blue and pure white tones with vibrant yellow eyes. Large scented

bicolor flowers providing months of color.

Bloom Period: Endless color from early spring through autumn.

Foliage: Small dark green foliage.

Habit: Compact rounded habit. Ideal for 4" pots, & early season containers & baskets.

Ultimately 8-12" x 8-12".

Propagation: Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.

Additional Comments: Pinch when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim after flowering to encourage good

habit a rapid re-flowering. Trim to re-flower in 3 in 4 weeks.

Uses: 4" pots, & early season containers, baskets, borders & mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
