Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Buddleja hybrid</i> (Code: BUD3)
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 23,464
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Full sized flowers 6-8", in ivory tones with warm yellow centers. Remove spent flower and feed to encourage re-blooming. Blooms continually for up to 5months.
Bloom Period:	Re-blooming. May to September.
Foliage:	Small to medium silver green leaves.
Habit:	Compact round shrub, 47" - x 36".
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to partial shade, fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Prune hard back to 3-4" in spring. Great for pollinator gardens. Loved by butterflies, bees and hummingbirds. Deer resistant.
Uses:	Containers, perennial borders and mass landscape planting.

2 Gallon:	12-14 weeks
