easy summer color. Colorfast.

**Bloom Period:** Endless color from early summer through first frosts.

**Habit:** Super tight compact rounded habit. Ideal for premium quart pots and patio containers.

Ultimately 8-12" x 8-12".

**Propagation:** Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.* 

**Culture:** Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.

Additional Comments: Common Name: Madagascar Periwinkle. Pinch when young to encourage strong basal branching.

Combo, 3 plants per: Coconut, Aqua + Grenadine to create Coronado Beach Mix.

**Uses:** Premium quarts, gallons, patio containers, borders & mass landscape planting.

## **Approximate Finishing Time**

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
