Ultimately 8-12" x 8-12".

Propagation: Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.

Additional Comments: Common Name: Madagascar Periwinkle. Pinch when young to encourage strong basal branching.

Combo, 3 plants per: Coconut, Aqua + Grenadine to create Coronado Beach Mix.

Uses: Premium quarts, gallons, patio containers, borders & mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
