Characteristics

Genus & Species:Dianthus hybridaProtection Status:US Plant Patent 24,363.USDA Zone:USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Early season highly scented double flowers. Unique coral colored flowers carried on sturdy stems.

Repeat flowering.

Bloom Period: Early season – Fall. **Foliage:** Blue silver foliage.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 6" x 4".

Propagation: Tip Cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed

and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

Uses: Containers, borders, mass landscape planting, cut flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 8-10 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-16 weeks
