Key Features

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Dianthus hybrida (Code: PPA 12.01)

Protection Status: PP 33,421

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Masses of highly scented vivid red flowers with bold central eye. Flower carried on sturdy stems.

Repeat flowering.

Bloom Period: Early season – Fall. **Foliage:** Silver-blue foliage.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 7" x 7".

Propagation: Tip Cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed

and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

Uses: Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 8-10 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-16 weeks

Comparison: D. Fire Star = 'Devon Xera'
