Bloom Period: Spring-Fall. Super long repeat blooming.

Foliage: High health glossy green foliage, exhibiting high disease resistance. **Habit:** Tidy petite rounded habit. 36" x 36". Excellent habit with no trimming.

Propagation: Semi hardwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.* **Culture:** Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.

low water landscapes.
