

Geranium 'Storm Cloud'

Key Features

- √ Vigorous selection with elegant heavily cut, colorful dark foliage.
- ✓ Robust strong habit. No staking required.
- Exceptionally long flowering period. Flowering continually from early season.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Geranium pratense (Code: TCN-10)

Protection Status: PP 34,969

Hardiness: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Vibrant deep flowers with elegant veining. Flowers up to 4cm in diameter.

Bloom Period: May - June. Second flowering: August - September.

Foliage: Elegant heavily cut dark colored foliage. Color phasing from early spring.

Habit: Tidy rounded habit. 24" x 24" at maturity.

Propagation: Tissue Culture. *License will be required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun – partial shade, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Exhibits good mildew resistant.

Uses: Containers, garden borders and landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 16-24 weeks

Comparison: G. Midnight Reiter

Key Differences:

- √ 'Storm Cloud' strong faster growing vs. average growing.
- ✓ 'Storm Cloud' large flower up to 4cm vs. smaller flowers 2-3cm.
- ✓ 'Strom Cloud' darker foliage vs. medium to dark foliage.
